




City of Keller, Texas Parks Master Plan Update

In 2013 Vista Planning & Design teamed with Livable Plans & Codes to update the City of Keller's parks and open space master plan. The process included the normal routine functions of a public project; analysis of existing plans, detailed discussions with City Council, Parks Board, and a wide variety of stakeholders and public engagement. Part of the contract was to develop concepts for four different parks. Two of the parks had some level of improvements while the other two had no improvements. The most important park was the main Keller Sports Park which had a number of issues to be addressed, mainly connecting to Old Town Keller.

Additionally, we conducted a detailed review of the entire trail system and Vista developed maps illustrating how strategic improvements can be made with the least investment thereby leveraging the City's dollars for the best and most equitable possible uses.
